What is New Zealand's First Solar PV project?

New Zealand renewables developer Lodestone Energy has started constructing its first solar PV project on the country's South Island, with a total generation capacity of 27.7MW. Located in South Canterbury, the Clandeboye solar PV power plant will supply clean energy to the milk processing and irrigation industries in the area.

How will the New Zealand solar farm project work?

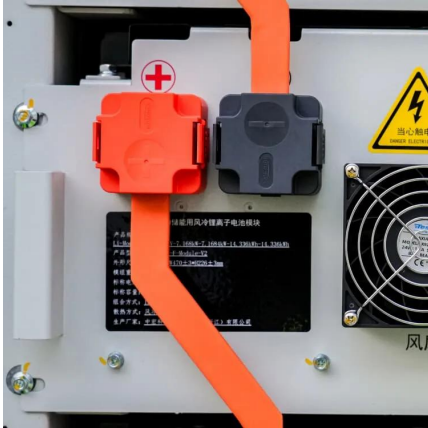
Mr Grogan said the solar farm project is supported by a power purchase arrangement with Meridian Energy, which will purchase 100% of the output for the first 10 years of operation. "The project demonstrates how government, industry, and financial institutions can work together to meet New Zealand's energy security and climate goals.

Are solar farms coming to New Zealand?

Distributed solar generation is expected to keep increasing, and New Zealand also now has some grid connected solar farm projects under construction, with more in the pipeline. The first large solar farm is expected to be completed this year.
