What is the normal inverter voltage in Greece





Overview

What is the voltage in Greece?

Just like the rest of Europe, the voltage in Greece is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Greece has standardized on type F sockets and plugs. Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets.

Do you need a power adapter in Greece?

A compatible power adapter will safeguard your phones, laptops, cameras, and other electronics from damage, allowing you to capture memories and stay connected throughout your Greek adventure. Which power outlets are used in Greece?

Greece uses two main plug types: C and F. Plug type C is the standard European plug with two round pins.

Do I need a voltage converter in Greece?

Greece operates on a standard voltage of 230 volts and a frequency of 50 Hz. If your home country uses the same voltage and frequency, you will not need a converter. However, if your home country uses a different voltage or frequency, you will need a voltage converter to safely use your electronic devices in Greece.

What does a travel plug adapter look like in Greece?

When you are going on a trip to Greece, be sure to pack the appropriate travel plug adapter that fits the local sockets. But what do those electrical outlets look like?

In Greece, types C and F are the official standards. Like almost all Continental European countries, Greece has standardized on the German plug and socket system.


